Golf Buggy and Cart Use



- 1. Some clubs permit players to wheel their buggies across tees and greens, while others do not. Check the club's policy.
- 2. Wherever possible, avoid following others near putting greens and creating worn tracks close to the edge of bunkers.



3. Do not wheel buggies through protected areas indicated by hoops, stakes/ropes and or signage.

4. Observe local notices regulating the movement of carts and avoid damaged and worn areas.

Rubbish



1. Place all rubbish in bins. If bins are not available on the course, retain the litter in your golf bag until the round is completed.
