



## INFORMATION IN RELATION TO COVID-19 (Coronavirus) 22.4.2020

Dear Member,

Firstly, thank you for your continued patience and co-operation in observing the Covid19 conditions. It goes without saying that this is one of, if not, the most challenging time in our Clubs' history.

The restrictions we have had to deal with are unprecedented, so we've had to be flexible with an amount of operational trial and error. For example, we moved the pro shop operations to outside in an effort to manage a free flow in the checking in process. Whilst this had some merit, we consider it is not sustainable in the longer term and even more challenging in inclement weather. The staff have moved back into the pro shop and with extra signage, increased number of distance markers and most of all your co-operation it is working as well as can be expected.

As we said in our last communication, we are trying to be as fair as possible to all members in the allocation of competition time slots, particularly on the most popular days of Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. We had intended to introduce '9 hole' competitions on those three days, particularly as we approach shorter daylight hours. The feedback from members has been in favour of continuing with '18 hole' competitions, but with restrictions on players booking in for more than one of those days.

In response to the feedback, we have put the idea of a '9 hole comp' on the backburner and will introduce the following conditions for Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday competitions commencing from Wednesday the 29th April.

- Members will be restricted to 'one live booking' for Wednesday, Saturday or Sunday competitions within any calendar week.
- Tee Bookings will be monitored by Club Administration and players booked into a second competition will be removed from the time sheet and receive an email notification.
- A player may book into a subsequent competition in the same week after 8:00pm on the day they have played.

- If there is a vacancy 24 hours prior to the competition hit-off you may book in.
  - This restriction applies only to Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday competitions.
- Players can book into multiple other competitions held during the week.
