Diggers Day, Par 3 Championship, Match Play Championship, Representative team news, new course ratings, a new Veterans prize and upcoming events are covered in this month's report.

Diggers Day was again a very successful event with an increased field size on last year, good weather and a significant donation made to Legacy. Bernie Herrenberg was this years' winner of the AIF Shield with 41 points. Through the contribution of members, players on the day and prize sponsors of the event a cheque for \$5,500 was presented to Legacy.



The Par 3 Championship again attracted a good field of competitors for a challenging day and once again it was shown that playing 18 par 3 holes is not as easy as it sounds. A slope rating of 95 brought all players into an equal opportunity of winning. Best nett score on the day was 41 points by Dennis Larsen and the best scratch being won by David Sheather with 37 points. The Major Pennant team have been in competition since February due to stoppages necessitated through COVID and are playing in the Final this Sunday at Riverside Oaks. The match against Cabramatta will determine this year's Pennant winner and all members are encouraged to attend and support the team from hit off time at 9:00am.

There have been numerous conversations over recent years on the disparity between handicaps and ratings for the 'Blue' and 'White' course competitions and tee markers at Cumberland. Golf NSW have completed a review of scores since 2014 and using an embedded process have altered the slope and scratch ratings for the 'Blue', 'White' and 'Red' courses. Without going into detail, there may be a small increase to some handicaps while the scratch ratings increase to 74 (Blue course), 72 (White course) and 75 (Red course). These changes will come into effect on Tuesday 15th December.

Our Cumberland Veteran Players have long been the backbone of Monday competitions, which were opened up to 'younger' golfers earlier this year during Covid. To acknowledge the Veteran's development and growth of the Monday competition there will be a guaranteed weekly prize for the best Singles score by a Member, or Lady Member, who qualify as a Veteran (over 50 yrs of age) in the Monday competition.

Don't miss our special events in December which consist of the Henderson - Stewart Trophy for Vets on Mondays 7th and 14th December. The Christmas Cup is another event not to be missed on Wednesday 9th December.
