
The AGM this year will be on Tuesday the 20th July 7.30pm sharp, with registrations open from 7pm.

VICE CAPTAINS REPORT - "Around the Greens"



Welcome to the June edition of 'Around the Greens'.

Over the month of June, we had approximately 65mm of rain. The dams are all at excellent levels with the 2nd & 5th dam at 100% capacity and the freshwater dam on the 12th currently at 80% capacity.

As winter has now arrived, the colour our fairways will slowly start to fade. As we have done in the past the course staff will add a green dye to the spraying program which will keep their colour during winter. Our fairways are in excellent condition and lovely to play off but again we need to make certain that all members carry a sand bucket and repair their divots and any others you may come across when playing your round of golf.

Some of our tees have struggled during May due to the rain, creating ideal conditions for disease. There has been an ongoing spraying program to try and rectify the problem.

Again, our greens continue to improve. I may be biased but I have played a few different courses over the past couple of months and I haven't seen any in better condition than ours. The amount of glowing praise from visiting pennant teams has been very complimentary.

Please make certain we continue to repair all lob marks

Our bunkers as we know are still a problem and we are working on a program to improve their quality. Course staff are currently removing any visible matting.

Work will commence on the removing of the fairway bunker between the 15th fairway and the 17th fairway on the 16th June. Please note their maybe some minimal course changes during the removal period (16th – 17th June).

Don't forget "Adopt a Hole" if your surname starts with a C or a D then your hole is the 3rd. Please take the time to fix your divots and lob marks.

The Bronze II pennant team has started the season with 3 great wins against Pymble (3:2), North Ryde (5:0) and Killara (4:1).


